1 **Relating to:** condemning political violence.

2 Whereas, the members of the Wisconsin State Assembly support the people's
3 right to peacefully assemble and exercise their First Amendment right to freedom
4 of speech; and

5 Whereas, peaceful political protest has a long and consequential history in this
6 country and has contributed to making the United States of America a better and
7 more just nation; and

8 Whereas, during this past year violence has erupted during political
9 demonstrations and protests, causing serious harm to persons and the destruction
10 of property; and

11 Whereas, individuals engaging in violent acts during protests and
12 demonstrations undermine the very political and social causes that they profess to
13 support; and

14 Whereas, political violence is strongly condemned by all responsible citizens
15 regardless of party affiliation; now, therefore, be it
