2015 SENATE BILL 400

November 20, 2015 – Introduced by Senators MARKLEIN and MOULTON, cosponsored by Representatives TRANEL, NOVAK, E. BROOKS, JARCHOW, STEFFEN and TITTL. Referred to Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 347.25 (3) of the statutes; relating to: lighting on vehicles in
 - a funeral procession.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the lead vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped with a flashing amber light. Any vehicle in the procession may also be equipped with a flashing amber light if all vehicles in the procession are so equipped. A vehicle equipped with such a light may only use the light in the procession. Under this bill, vehicles permitted to be equipped with a flashing amber light may instead be equipped with a flashing purple light.

SECTION 1. 347.25 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

- 4 347.25 (3) The lead vehicle in a funeral procession may be equipped, or any
- 5 vehicle in the procession may be equipped if all vehicles in the procession are so
- 6 equipped, with a flashing amber <u>or purple</u> light that may be used only in the
- 7 procession.
