2013 SENATE BILL 423

December 10, 2013 – Introduced by LAW REVISION COMMITTEE. Referred to Elections and Urban Affairs.

AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

1 AN ACT *to repeal* subchapter I (title) of chapter 10 [precedes 10.01] and
2 subchapter II of chapter 10 [precedes 10.51]; and *to amend* chapter 10 (title)
3 of the statutes; **relating to:** repealing the schedule of election occurrences.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Subchapter II of chapter 10 of the Wisconsin Statutes contains a chronologically arranged schedule of election occurrences (schedule). This subchapter provides that the schedule shall not be considered substantive law. The subchapter also requires the Legislative Reference Bureau to update the schedule in response to changes to the laws relating to elections and include the updates in a correction bill. This bill repeals the subchapter.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 SECTION 1. Chapter 10 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 CHAPTER 10

6 ELECTION DATES AND NOTICES

7 SECTION 2. Subchapter I (title) of chapter 10 [precedes 10.01] of the statutes
8 is repealed.
