1 **AN ACT to create** 20.285 (1) (em) and 36.27 (3q) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 resident undergraduate tuition remission at the University of Wisconsin
3 System for student teachers and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides for a semester of full undergraduate tuition remission to resident undergraduate students enrolled in a teaching program at a University of Wisconsin System institution during the student's semester of student teaching.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.285 (1) (em) of the statutes is created to read:
5 20.285 (1) (em) *Student teacher tuition remission.* A sum sufficient to
6 reimburse the University of Wisconsin System for student teacher tuition remissions
7 under s. 36.27 (3q).
