2017 SENATE BILL 787

February 7, 2018 - Introduced by Senators L. TAYLOR, DARLING, BEWLEY, PETROWSKI, ERPENBACH, CARPENTER, SHILLING and TESTIN, cosponsored by Representatives ROHRKASTE, STEINEKE, JACQUE, SHANKLAND, ANDERSON, BALLWEG, SINICKI, ZEPNICK, TITTL, SPREITZER, TUSLER, BERCEAU, SPIROS, MURSAU and VANDERMEER. Referred to Joint Committee on Finance.

1 **AN ACT to create** 20.255 (3) (ct) and 115.28 (44) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 grants to the Center for Suicide Awareness, Inc., and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Public Instruction to annually provide a grant to the Center for Suicide Awareness, Inc. The purpose of the grant is to provide funding for staff, training, and expenses related to operating a text-based suicide prevention service. In each of the 2017-18 and 2018-19 fiscal years, the amount of the grant to the Center for Suicide Awareness, Inc., is \$110,000.

9 115.28 (44) CENTER FOR SUICIDE AWARENESS. Annually, distribute the amounts
10 appropriated under s. 20.255 (3) (ct) to the Center for Suicide Awareness, Inc., to
11 support staff, training, and expenses related to operating a text-based suicide
12 prevention service.
