AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- 1 AN ACT to amend 125.09 (7) of the statutes; relating to: providing alcohol
- 2 beverage retailers with identification scanners.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits municipalities from providing to alcohol beverage retail licensees any device capable of scanning a driver's license or identification card issued by the Department of Transportation.

The bill repeals this prohibition and also prohibits a municipality that provides such a device from collecting or retaining data derived from the device.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 125.09 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 125.09 (7) MUNICIPALITY PROVIDING IDENTIFICATION SCANNERS. No If a municipality may provide, provides to any retail licensee under this chapter, any
- device capable of scanning an official identification card, as defined in s. 125.085 (1)
- 7 (a) and (b), the municipality may not collect or retain data derived from the device.
