2	Education Month in Wisconsin.
3	Whereas, Wisconsin's educational institutions including world-class public
4	schools and technical colleges are an invaluable resource for Career and Technical
5	Education (CTE); and
6	Whereas, CTE programs provide multiple pathways for students to become
7	college and career ready while still in high school and are utilized by nearly
8	two-thirds of our state's high schoolers — with 88,000 taking CTE courses in areas
9	such as health occupations, manufacturing, technology and engineering,
10	agriculture, and business; and
11	Whereas, Wisconsin benefits from tremendous cooperation between
12	businesses, schools, and technical colleges that creates opportunity for students to
13	explore careers, earn industry certification, and gain postsecondary credit while
14	working toward high school graduation; and

Whereas, Wisconsin has been a national leader in skill, quality, and work ethic
 due in no small part to the foresight and focus on technical education opportunities;
