2017 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 16

March 9, 2017 - Introduced by Senators Darling, L. Taylor, Ringhand, Risser, Olsen, C. Larson and Marklein, cosponsored by Representatives E. Brooks, Anderson, Berceau, Crowley, Fields, Hesselbein, Murphy, Pope, Ripp and Sinicki. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

2 Whereas, Kirby Hendee was born on March 12, 1923, and died on March 11, 3 2016; and Whereas, Kirby Hendee graduated from St. Roberts grade school and 4 5 Shorewood High School; and 6 Whereas, Kirby Hendee was a World War II veteran, serving in the U.S. Army 7 from 1943 to 1946; and 8 Whereas, after the war, Kirby Hendee attended Holy Cross College, graduating 9 in 1950, and the University of Michigan Law School, receiving his LLB in 1953; and 10 Whereas, Kirby Hendee was elected to the Wisconsin Senate in 1956, serving in the 1957 session on the Judiciary and Labor, Taxation, Insurance, and Banking 11 12 Committees, and in the 1959 session on the Joint Committee on Finance, and in both 13 sessions on the Joint Survey Committee on Retirement Systems; and

Relating to: the life and public service of Kirby Hendee.

1	Whereas, after an unsuccessful campaign for a seat in the U.S. House of
2	Representatives in 1960, Hendee went to work as an attorney in the insurance
3	industry; and
4	Whereas, in 1971 Kirby Hendee began a long career as a lobbyist for a diverse
5	group of clients, representing the banking industry, the insurance industry, public
6	utilities, and many others; and
7	Whereas, Kirby Hendee became a well-known person in the Capitol, widely
8	admired for his wit, dedication, and honesty, serving as a lobbyist until his
9	retirement in 1988; now, therefore, be it
10	Resolved by the senate, the assembly concurring, That the legislature
11	salutes Kirby Hendee's public service, remembers fondly his many years in the
12	Capitol, and mourns his passing; and, be it further
13	Resolved, That the senate chief clerk shall provide a copy of this resolution to
14	his son, James.
