2 Whereas, James Jeskewitz lived a life devoted to family, football, coaching, and
3 teaching; and

4 Whereas, James was a standout football player at UW–La Crosse, and later
5 signed a professional football contract; and

6 Whereas, James was a dedicated coach and teacher, leading the Menomonee
7 Falls football team to 199 wins over 28 seasons and the 1976 WIAA State
8 Championship; and

9 Whereas, James was named to the Wisconsin Football Coaches Hall of Fame,
10 the UW–La Crosse Athletic Hall of Fame, and the Menomonee Falls High School
11 Hall of Fame; and

12 Whereas, after retiring from coaching and teaching, James continued to serve
13 as a leader in his community as a village trustee for Menomonee Falls and as
14 Waukesha County Board supervisor; and
