Section 333.

(a) There is appropriated one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) from the general fund to the department of state parks and cultural resources for the purpose of conducting impact assessment studies as provided under this section.

(b) For any fairground, rodeo or public sale barn site that is offered for sale or other transfer of title that the department of state parks and cultural resources identifies as having historic importance for the state of Wyoming, the department of state parks and cultural resources shall conduct a study of the economic and cultural impacts that may result to the community if the sale or transfer of the site is completed. The department shall consult with the Wyoming tourism board on the potential impact to travel and tourism in the state for any study conducted under this section.

(c) The maximum amount to be expended for any single impact assessment study under this section shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00).

(d) This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2024.

(e) It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be included in the department of state parks and cultural resource's standard budget for the immediately succeeding fiscal biennium."
