Page 141-after line 8 Insert:

"(f) Of any unobligated, unexpended funds appropriated under this section, there is appropriated three million three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$3,350,000.00) to the office of the governor for the purposes specified in this subsection. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, funds appropriated in this subsection shall not require any match before expenditure in accordance with this section:

(i) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) to be expended for administrative purposes;

(ii) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for the development of a project based on the model of the industrial heartland area in Alberta, Canada;

(iii) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to encourage the development and construction of natural gas to liquid fuels facilities in the state of Wyoming;

(iv) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to encourage the development and construction of electronics manufacturing facilities in Wyoming;

(v) Eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000.00) to improve Wyoming's access to and growth in domestic and international markets for Wyoming's products and natural resources;

1 (vi) One million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to develop
2 Wyoming's energy initiatives, including but not limited to
3 baseline water testing, carbon dioxide pipeline corridors, an
4 energy atlas, hydrogen projects, trona projects, soda ash
5 projects, liquid natural gas infrastructure planning and hybrid
6 energy solutions and strategies;

8 (vii) One million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to develop
9 economic development initiatives likely to provide a substantial
10 public benefit to the state of Wyoming, including but not limited
11 to opportunities for economic development and land purchases along
12 Wyoming's interstate and major transportation corridors, the
13 creation, development or purchase of museums in Wyoming and the
14 development or expansion of major tourist events in Wyoming;

16 (viii) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to encourage
17 the research or development of flat glass manufacturing in Wyoming;
