14 Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2. "ARPD" shall not include expenditures  
15 authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2  
16 and section 602(c)(1)(C) of Title VI of the federal Social Security  
17 Act for revenue replacement for the provision of government  
18 services to the extent of the state of Wyoming's reduction in  
19 revenue."

27 (a) Any unexpended, unobligated funds appropriated in 2022  
28 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 50, Section 2, Section 400, as  
29 amended by 2023 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 188, Section 2, and  
30 2023 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 188, Section 3, Section 401 and  
31 any other ARPD funds that are not fully committed or obligated in  
32 accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2,  
33 and any applicable rules, regulations or guidance by April 1, 2024  
34 shall revert on April 1, 2024 to the office of the governor for  
35 purposes of this section.  
36

1 (b) On April 1, 2024, funds reverted under this section and  
2 any unappropriated ARPD funds are hereby reappropriated and  
3 appropriated to the office of the governor and shall be expended  
4 for purposes of programs and projects eligible for expenditure  
5 with ARPD funds. The governor shall obligate funds reappropriated  
6 and appropriated under this subsection not later than December 31,  
7 2024 on any other projects or uses eligible under the American  
8 Rescue Plan Act that are identified by the governor.

9  
10 (c) There is appropriated such amounts as may be necessary  
11 from section 602(c)(1)(C) of Title VI of the federal Social  
12 Security Act, as created by section 9901 of the American Rescue  
13 Plan Act of 2021, specifically expended for the provision of  
14 generally funded government services in this act to the extent of  
15 the reduction in revenue under section 602(c)(1)(C). Expenditures  
16 authorized under this subsection shall be approved by the governor  
17 and reported to the joint appropriations committee through the  
18 B-11 process as authorized by W.S. 9-2-1005(b)(ii) and reported  
19 pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1013(b).

20  
21 (d) It is the intent of the legislature that the  
22 appropriations and reappropriations in this section not be  
23 included in the respective agencies' standard budgets for the  
24 immediately succeeding fiscal biennium, unless otherwise  
25 specifically provided.

26  
27 (e) No expenditure of funds shall be made under this section  
28 except in accordance with state and federal law, regulations and  
29 orders.

30  
31 (f) The governor shall implement reporting requirements on  
32 the recipient of any grant, distribution or aid authorized under  
33 this section sufficient to comply with all federal reporting  
34 requirements.

35  
36 (g) The governor is authorized to establish by order or rule  
37 emergency programs for which funds are appropriated in this section  
38 that are consistent with the terms of the American Rescue Plan Act  
39 and that do not obligate the state to make any expenditures of  
40 state funds not appropriated by the legislature. Any emergency  
41 program under the authority granted in this section shall expire  
42 on December 31, 2026 unless expressly continued by action of the  
43 legislature.

45 (h) Funds appropriated under this section shall be obligated  
46 in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act and any applicable

1 rules or guidance not later than December 31, 2024, unless a later  
2 date is specified by federal law, rule or guidance.

3  
4 (j) The governor shall report to the joint appropriations  
5 committee on a monthly basis on all of the following:

7 (i) The aggregate allocation of funds appropriated in  
8 this section, by program;

10 (ii) Program expenditures;

11  
12 (iii) Grant awards;

14 (iv) Grant expenditures.

16 (k) Nothing in this section shall be construed to modify or  
17 impair any existing contract or obligation of the state that is  
18 executed or incurred on or before the effective date of this  
19 section.

21 (m) It is the intent of the legislature that this section be  
22 given precedence and prevail over 2024 Senate File 0132, if enacted  
23 into law."
