**"Section 4.**

27 (a) The department of transportation Wyoming information  
28 system (WIS) shall be purchased or developed, configured and  
29 implemented in consultation with the University of Wyoming  
30 computer science department (University) and the department of  
31 enterprise technology services (ETS). The purchase or development,  
32 configuration, migration and full implementation of WIS (the WIS  
33 project) shall be a jointly undertaken for the benefit of the state  
34 of Wyoming as provided in this section.

35  
36 (b) The University and ETS shall guide and advise the  
37 department of transportation on all aspects of the WIS project,  
38 including assistance with the issuance of a request for proposals.  
39 The request for proposals shall ensure that upon implementation  
40 and throughout its life, WIS:

41  
42 (i) Provides efficient information exchange among  
43 diverse public and private partners;

1 (ii) Complies with accepted national industry standards  
2 for personal, revenue and tax information exchange and storage  
3 systems, including but not limited to:

4  
5 (A) National Information Exchange Model (NIEM);

6  
7 (B) Payment Card Industry standards;

8  
9 (C) National Institute of Standards and Technology  
10 cyber security and other applicable standards; and

11  
12 (D) Internal Revenue Publication 4812 Audit and  
13 Accountability Requirements.

14  
15 (iii) Is hosted in the most efficient, effective and  
16 economical redundant state of the art environments;

17  
18 (iv) Continually evolves to incorporate innovative  
19 technology to improve operational and economic efficiencies.

20  
21 (c) The department of transportation, University and ETS  
22 shall consult with public and private partners who will access,  
23 share or exchange information with WIS before issuance of the  
24 request for proposals to plan for coordination throughout the life  
25 of the project, including the office of the attorney general and  
26 other executive branch agencies, the supreme court and local and  
27 federal agencies.

28  
29 (d) The department of transportation, in consultation with  
30 the University and ETS, shall create a committee to review and  
31 make recommendations to the department of transportation on vendor  
32 and system selection. The committee shall consist of no more than  
33 twelve (12) members. Members shall possess in-depth knowledge of  
34 large-scale computer information exchange and storage systems.  
35 The committee shall include:

36  
37 (i) Two (2) members selected by the director of ETS,  
38 one (1) of whom shall serve as chairman;

39  
40 (ii) Two (2) members selected by the chairmen of the  
41 joint transportation, highways and military affairs interim  
42 committee;

43  
44 (iii) Two (2) members selected by the chairmen of the  
45 joint appropriations committee;

46  
47 (iv) Two (2) members selected by the University;

2 (v) Two (2) members selected by the department of  
3 transportation from an entities who will exchange data with WIS;  
4

5 (vi) Two (2) members selected by the department of  
6 transportation.  
7

8 (e) The committee created under subsection (c) of this  
9 section shall receive product demonstrations from vendors chosen  
10 jointly by the department of transportation, the University and  
11 ETS from vendors responding to the request for proposals.  
12

13 (f) No later than July 1, 2021, the department of  
14 transportation, University and ETS shall provide to the joint  
15 transportation, highways and military affairs interim committee  
16 and to the joint appropriations committee a proposed timeline for  
17 each phase of the WIS project. The timeline shall anticipate a  
18 full configuration, migration, implementation and closeout of the  
19 WIS project no later than July 1, 2027.  
20

21 (g) The department of transportation, University and ETS  
22 shall provide a written and verbal joint report to the  
23 transportation, highways and military affairs interim committee  
24 and to the joint appropriations committee at their next meetings  
25 after July 1, 2021 and each following meeting until closeout of  
26 the WIS project. The reports shall provide a brief update as to:  
27

28 (i) Project schedule, successes and lessons learned;  
29

30 (ii) Resources acquired and needed throughout each  
31 project phase, including project management, department of  
32 transportation subject matter experts, outside subject matter  
33 experts and consultants;  
34

35 (iii) An accounting of funds received and expended from  
36 the transportation information system account;  
37

38 (iv) Project budget.  
39

40 (h) The department of transportation, University and ETS  
41 shall develop a reimbursement schedule for consulting and other  
42 services provided by the University and ETS to the department of  
43 transportation under this act. The schedule shall be submitted to  
44 the transportation, highways and military affairs interim  
45 committee and joint appropriations committee no later than July 1,  
46 2021."

3 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section,  
4 this act is effective July 1, 2021.

6 (b) Sections 3, 4 and 5 of this act shall be effective  
7 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to  
8 become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
