A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to service of process fees; providing for
2 setting of service of process fees biennially; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-3-608(a) (intro) is amended to
8 read:

10 **18-3-608. Fees generally.**

12 (a) For the serving of process according to the
13 Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure, each county sheriff shall
14 receive from the party requesting service a single fee, to
15 be determined and set ~~biannually~~ biennially by the board of
16 county commissioners after a public hearing, paid in
17 advance to be credited to the county general fund, not to

1 exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first three (3)
2 attempts at service at a different time and date for each
3 attempt. Thereafter a fee not to exceed ten dollars
4 (\$10.00) may be charged for each succeeding attempt. The
5 court may waive the fees upon an adequate showing of
6 indigency. Any fees waived may, pursuant to court order,
7 be assessed and collected against any judgment rendered.
8 Each county sheriff shall receive from the party for whom
9 service is rendered in civil cases the following fees which
10 shall be transmitted to the county treasurer to be credited
11 to the county general fund and which shall be paid in
12 advance if demanded by the sheriff from the party for whom
13 the service is rendered:

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
