7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-601(b) is amended to read:

- 12 (b) A licensee, or the executor or administrator of
- 13 the estate of a deceased licensee, may assign and transfer
- 14 the license or permit by a sale made in good faith. The
- 15 assignment and transfer shall first have the approval of
- 16 the licensing authority, which consideration shall be based

1 in part upon a public hearing and an application filed 2 under oath by the assignee or transferee showing the person 3 or entity to be qualified to hold a license or permit under Wyoming law. The approval of the transfer shall not be 4 5 given by the licensing authority if proceedings, including an action to collect delinquent sales tax payments the 6 7 transferring licensee is certified by the department as sixty (60) or more days delinquent in paying sales taxes 8 9 pursuant to W.S. 12-2-306, or if proceedings are pending to suspend, revoke or otherwise penalize the original license 10 11 or permit holder. A transfer of a license or permit shall require the payment of an additional license fee to the 12 appropriate licensing authority of not more 13 than hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the transfer, 14 and upon assignment the assignee may exercise the privilege of 15 continuing the business authorized by the license 16 17 permit.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
