1 AN ACT relating to energy and natural resources; creating the

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10 Section 1.

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12 (a) There is created the Wyoming coal marketing program
13 to be administered by the governor. The purpose of the program
14 is to protect and expand Wyoming's coal markets and coal

15 facilities and to address impacts cities, towns and counties

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1 have experienced or will experience due to changes in the

2 coal market.

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4 (b) The governor shall expend funds appropriated to the

5 governor for operating the program only on the following:

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7 (i) Projects with a public benefit associated with

8 expanding and protecting Wyoming's coal markets and coal

9 facilities;

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11 (ii) Projects that address impacts cities, towns

12 and counties have experienced or will experience due to

13 changes in the coal market.

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15 (c) No funds shall be provided for projects under this

16 chapter without the written opinion of the attorney general

17 certifying the legality of the transaction and all documents

18 connected therewith.

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20 (d) On or before October 1 of each year, the governor

21 shall report to the joint minerals, business and economic

22 development interim committee on the projects funded by the

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1 coal marketing program. The report shall include the amount,

2 the recipient and a description of each project funded.

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4 There is created the Wyoming coal marketing program All funds in the continuously 5 account. account are 6 appropriated to the governor to be expended for the purposes of this chapter and as otherwise specified by law. The 7 8 governor may expend funds in this account as provided in subsection (b) of this section. Interest earned on funds in 9

10 the account shall be deposited in the account.

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(f) The governor may accept, and shall deposit in the account, any gifts, contributions, donations, grants or federal funds specifically designated for the benefit of the Wyoming coal marketing program or any project funded under the program.

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Section 2. There is appropriated one million dollars

(\$1,000,000.00) from the general fund to the coal marketing

program account created by Section 1(e) of this act. The

governor shall only expend this appropriation for the Wyoming

coal marketing program as provided for in Section 1 of this

act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

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1 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 2 other purpose. 3 4 Section 3. The governor shall promulgate any rules 5 necessary to implement the Wyoming coal marketing program. 6 Section 4. 7 8 9 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this act is effective July 1, 2020. 10 11 12 (b) Sections 3 and 4 of this act are effective 13 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill 14 to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 15
