(a) There is created the Wyoming coal marketing program
to be administered by the governor. The purpose of the program
is to protect and expand Wyoming's coal markets and coal

1 have experienced or will experience due to changes in the 2 coal market. 3 4 (b) The governor shall expend funds appropriated to the governor for operating the program only on the following: 5 б 7 (i) Projects with a public benefit associated with 8 expanding and protecting Wyoming's coal markets and coal facilities; 9 10 11 (ii) Projects with a public benefit that address 12 impacts cities, towns and counties have experienced or will experience due to changes in the coal market. 13 14 (c) No funds shall be provided for projects under this 15 16 chapter without the written opinion of the attorney general 17 certifying the legality of the transaction and all documents connected therewith. 18 19 20 (d) On or before October 1 of each year, the governor shall report to the joint minerals, business and economic 21 development interim committee on the projects funded by the 22

coal marketing program. The report shall include the amount,
 the recipient and a description of each project funded.

4 (e) There is created the Wyoming coal marketing program 5 account. All funds in the continuously account are 6 appropriated to the governor to be expended for the purposes of this chapter and as otherwise specified by law. The 7 8 governor may expend funds in this account as provided in subsection (b) of this section. Interest earned on funds in 9 10 the account shall be deposited in the account.

12 (f) The governor may accept, and shall deposit in the 13 account, any gifts, contributions, donations, grants or 14 federal funds specifically designated for the benefit of the 15 Wyoming coal marketing program or any project funded under 16 the program.

Section 2. There is appropriated one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from the general fund to the coal marketing program account created by Section 1(e) of this act. The governor shall only expend this appropriation for the Wyoming coal marketing program as provided for in Section 1 of this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

The governor shall promulgate any rules 5 necessary to implement the Wyoming coal marketing program. б Section 4. 7 8 9 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this act is effective July 1, 2020. 10 11 12 (b) Sections 3 and 4 of this act are effective 13 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill 14 to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 15 16 17 (END)
