1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; authorizing the donation 2 of an antelope hunting license to a qualifying youth hunter; making conforming amendments; reformatting similar 3 4 provisions to promote consistency; and providing for an 5 effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 23-1-701(b)(i), 23-1-705(k) and by 10 creating a new subsection (m) and 23-2-306(c) are amended 11 to read: 12 13 23-1-701. Selling agents; administration of oaths; 14 licenses, permits and game tags.

(b) Each license selling agent shall charge a fee as 1 2 provided in this subsection for each license, permit or 3 stamp he sells or distributes pursuant to this act. The 4 fee shall not be charged if this act specifies that the issuance shall be without fee or fails to establish a fee 5 for the issuance of the license, permit or stamp. 6 Each license, permit or stamp sold or distributed under this act 7 8 shall display the total amount only of all fees and other 9 charges required under this act or otherwise provided by 10 Each selling agent shall retain two dollars (\$2.00) law. 11 for each license and fifty cents (\$.50) for each stamp or 12 permit he sells. For failure to comply with this section, 13 selling agents shall not be entitled to retain the amounts specified in this subsection and shall be liable on their 14 15 bond. No employee of the commission shall receive any 16 commission on licenses, stamps or permits sold, but the department shall charge the additional fee specified in 17 18 this subsection, or otherwise provided by law, for each 19 license, stamp or permit sold by commission employees. The 20 fee charged under this subsection shall be in addition to 21 the amount otherwise established by this act for the 22 license, permit or stamp and shall be as follows:

12 (k) The holder of any valid big game license may surrender said the license to the department for reissuance 13 to a veteran with disabilities or a person with a permanent 14 disability who uses a wheelchair as established by 15 commission rule and regulation who was selected and 16 17 sponsored by a nonprofit charitable organization providing which provides hunting opportunities for disabled veterans 18 19 or persons with permanent disabilities who use wheelchairs. 20 Any The department shall promulgate rules to carry out the 21 provisions of this subsection. 6	youth hunter who is twelve (12) years of age at the time
7	the license is reissued. The department shall promulgate
8	rules to carry out the provisions of this subsection. A
9	license reissued in accordance with the provisions of this
10	subsection shall:

12	(i) Be for the same area and license type as the
13	donated license;

15	(ii) Be reissued by the department to a
16	qualifying youth hunter at no fee;

18	(iii) Not be sold, traded, auctioned or offered
19	for monetary value or issued to, used by or reissued to any
