7	Section 1. W.S. 31-7-110(e) is amended to read:

9	31-7-110. Instruction and temporary driver's permits.

11	(e) Any person who holds a valid Wyoming classified
12	driver's license and who is at least eighteen (18) years of
13	age may apply to the division for a commercial learner's
14	permit. The division may, after the person has successfully
15	passed all required examination examinations, other than the

1 driving skills examination and paid the required fee, issue 2 to the person a commercial learner's permit, which entitles 3 the person to drive a commercial motor vehicle on a highway 4 only when accompanied by a person who has a commercial 5 driver's license valid for the type of vehicle driven and who occupies a seat beside the person for the purpose of giving 6 instruction in driving the commercial motor vehicle. The 7 8 commercial learner's permit may not be issued for a period to 9 exceed one hundred eighty (180) days and only one (1) renewal 10 may be granted for an additional period of one hundred eighty (180) days three hundred sixty-five (365) days. Every person 11 12 holding a commercial driver's license shall obtain a 13 commercial learner's permit prior to upgrading their 14 commercial driver's license to a higher class type, adding an endorsement or removing a restriction which requires a skills 15 16 test. 17 18 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2020. 19 20 (END)
