A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to unemployment insurance; amending
2 information that an employer must submit to the state
3 directory of new hires; and providing for an effective
4 date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-1-115(b) is amended to read:

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10 **27-1-115. State directory of new hires; requirements;**
11 **exceptions; definitions.**

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13 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this
14 section, each employer in the state shall furnish to the
15 department of employment within twenty (20) days of hiring
16 a new employee, or in the case of an employer transmitting

1 reports magnetically or electronically, by two (2) monthly
2 transmissions not less than twelve (12) days nor more than
3 sixteen (16) days apart, a report that contains the name,
4 address and social security number of the employee, the
5 date services for remuneration were first performed by the
6 employee and the name and address of, and identifying
7 number assigned to, the employer under section 6109 of the
8 Internal Revenue Code. The report shall be made on a W-4
9 form approved by the internal revenue service or, at the
10 option of the employer, on an equivalent form approved by
11 the department. The form may be transmitted by first class
12 mail, electronically or magnetically in a format acceptable
13 to the designated department.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2012.
