Hathaway success curriculum-2.

Sponsored by: Joint Education Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; modifying the requirements of  
2 the Hathaway success curriculum as specified; and providing  
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1307(b) (intro), (v),  
8 (d) (intro), (v) and (e) (intro) and (ii) is amended to read:

9

10 **21-16-1307. Success curriculum; test standards.**

11

12 (b) The success curriculum required to qualify for  
13 honor or performance scholarship eligibility under this  
14 article for students graduating from high school in the  
15 2010-2011 school year and each school year thereafter shall  
16 be as follows:

1 (v) One (1) of the following:

2

3 (A) Foreign language - two (2) sequenced  
4 years of the same foreign language which need not be taken  
5 consecutively, at least one (1) of which shall be taken in  
6 grades nine (9) through twelve (12). Two (2) sequenced  
7 years of instruction in the native language of the Eastern  
8 Shoshone or the Northern Arapaho, or two (2) sequenced  
9 years of instruction in American sign language, either of  
10 which need not be taken consecutively but at least one (1)  
11 year of which is taken in grades nine (9) through twelve  
12 (12), may be taken in fulfillment of this ~~paragraph.~~  
13 subparagraph; or

14

15 (B) Fine and performing arts - two (2)  
16 years of instruction in fine and performing arts, all of  
17 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve  
18 (12); or

19

20 (C) Career-vocational education - two (2)  
21 years of instruction in career-vocational education, all of  
22 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve  
23 (12).

1 (d) The success curriculum required to qualify for  
2 opportunity scholarship eligibility under this article for  
3 students graduating from high school in the 2010-2011  
4 school year and each school year thereafter shall be as  
5 follows:

7 (v) One (1) of the following:

9 (A) Foreign language - demonstrate  
10 proficiency on the state standards for the foreign cultures  
11 and languages common core of knowledge requirement under  
12 W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(K) which may include American sign  
13 language as one (1) component of foreign language  
14 proficiency; ~~or~~ or

15

16 (B) Fine and performing arts - demonstrate  
17 proficiency on the state standards for the fine and  
18 performing arts common core of knowledge requirement under  
19 W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(E); or

20

21 (C) Career-vocational education -  
22 demonstrate proficiency in the state standards for the  
23 career-vocational education common core of knowledge  
24 requirement under W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(J).

2 (e) The success curriculum required to qualify for  
3 provisional opportunity scholarship eligibility under this  
4 article for students graduating from high school in the  
5 2010-2011 school year and each school year thereafter shall  
6 be the curriculum required for high school graduation under  
7 W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii) subject to the following:

8

9 (ii) Demonstration of proficiency on the state  
10 standards for:

11

12 (A) The foreign cultures and languages  
13 common core of knowledge requirement under W.S.  
14 21-9-101(b)(i)(K) which may include American sign language  
15 as one (1) component of foreign language proficiency; ~~or~~ or

17 (B) The fine and performing arts common  
18 core of knowledge requirement under W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(E);  
19 or

20

21 (C) The career-vocational education common  
22 core of knowledge requirement under W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(J).

1           **Section 2.**   This act is effective immediately upon  
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
4 Constitution.
