A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to weed and pest control; modifying 2 definitions; providing for emergency declarations;
- 3 providing for district boards to buy and sell property and
- 4 equipment; repealing provision establishing inspectors as
- 5 district supervisors; modifying cost sharing with
- 6 landowners; increasing the amount on surety bonds;
- 7 requiring reports to the district board; increasing the
- 8 criminal penalty amount; providing conforming amendments;
- 9 and providing for an effective date.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 13 Section 1. W.S. 11-1-103, 11-5-101, 11-5-102(a)(i),

- 15 by creating a new paragraph (xxiii) and by renumbering

2 (b) The purpose of this act is controlling designated 3 and declared weeds and pests. 4 5 11-5-102. Definitions. 6 (a) As used in this act: 7 8 9 (i) "Agricultural "Pesticide" means any material used to control or eradicate weeds or pests; 10 11 (ii) "Authorized dealer" means a resident of any 12 13 pesticide dealer licensed in Wyoming who sells, retails, wholesales, distributes, offers or exposes for sale, 14 exchanges, barters or gives away any agricultural pesticide 15 within this state; 16 17 (v) "Control" means the process of containing, 18 and limiting weed and pest infestations preventing, 19 20 identifying and mitigating weed and pest infestations by

using multiple integrated management practices, including

but not limited to, regulation, prevention, survey,

eradication, pesticides, cultivation, competition, grazing

1 designed to reduce economic and ecological impacts from designated and declared species and to protect uninfested 2 3 lands; 4 5 (vii) "Declared pest" means any animal or insect species which the board and the Wyoming weed and pest 6 council have found, either by virtue of its direct or 7 indirect effect to negatively impact management of 8 9 agricultural or natural ecosystems, or as a carrier of disease or parasites, to be detrimental to the general 10 11 welfare of persons residing within a district; 12 13 (viii) "Declared weed" means any plant species 14 which the board and the Wyoming weed and pest council have found, either by virtue of its direct or indirect effect to 15 negatively impact management of agricultural or natural 16 17 ecosystems, or as a carrier of disease or parasites, to be detrimental to the general welfare of persons residing 18 within a district; 19 20 21 (x)"Designated list" means the list of weeds 22 and pests from time to time designated by joint resolution 23 of the board and the Wyoming weed and pest council or by an 24 emergency declaration of the director;

1	11-5-104. District board of directors; appointment;
2	terms; vacancies; compensation and expenses.

4	(g) At the first regular meeting in February the
5	district board shall elect from its members a chairman and
6	a vice-chairman, and appoint a secretary and a treasurer.
7	The positions of secretary and treasurer need not be
8	members of the district board. The treasurer shall furnish
9	a surety bond to the district before entering upon the
10	duties of office in an amount to be set by the district
11	board but not less than three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00)
12	fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

7	A board of certification is established consisting of the
8	director or his designee, a University of Wyoming weed or
9	pest specialist appointed by the dean of the college of
10	agriculture, two (2) certified district supervisors and a
11	district board member appointed by the Wyoming weed and
12	pest council. The board of certification shall promulgate
13	rules and requirements for certification of district
14	supervisors and shall certify all personnel meeting the
15	established requirements.—All inspectors certified as of
16	February 10, 1973 are deemed certified district supervisors
17	without any further actions of the board of certification.

19	11-5-107. Purchase and sale of pesticides; cost share
20	with landowner.

22	(a) The district board may purchase from authorized
23	dealers such quantities of agricultural pesticides and
24	equipment as are necessary, and hire labor to carry out the

1 provisions of this act. Warrants in payment shall be drawn

on the weed and pest control fund. 2

- (b) The district board may sell agricultural 4
- 5 pesticides which have been registered with the department
- for weed and pest control. 6

- (d) The district board may cost share with the 8
- 9 landowner the cost of the pesticides, the cost of the
- application and the cost of any other integrated management 10
- practice for the control of designated or declared noxious 11
- 12 weeds and pests.

- 11-5-108. Rates and application of pesticides; 14
- payment by landowner; bidding restriction. 15

- 17 The district board may establish rates and engage
- in the application of agricultural pesticides for weed and 18
- pest control, subject to subsection (b) of this section. 19
- The district board may cost share in the agricultural 20
- 21 pesticides, and the landowner shall pay the full cost of
- 22 the application. If services provided are not paid for by
- landowner for whom rendered as provided in W.S. 23 the

1 11-5-107(d), such indebtedness may be collected as provided by W.S. 11-5-107(c). 2 3 4 11-5-115. Program in cities and towns authorized; 5 funding; use of monies.

(c) Monies received by the cities from the district 7 may shall be used in any phase of weed and pest control to 8 9 control noxious weeds and pests as determined by the 10 governing body of the city or town. The control program 11 shall include work on designated weeds and pests as determined by the district board The city or town shall 12 13 provide an annual report to the district board on 14 designated and declared weed and pest work completed within the jurisdictional limits of the city or town. 15

11-5-117. Criminal provision; penalty. 17

19 Any person violating any provision of this act, is guilty 20 of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined not more than one 21 hundred dollars (\$100.00) in addition to fines provided for 22 in W.S. 11 5 109(e) other than W.S. 11-5-109, shall be 23 punished as provided in W.S. 11-1-103.
