## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; amending the definition
- 2 of "antique"; amending criteria to obtain antique vehicle
- 3 licensure; requiring insurance; amending the format of
- 4 antique vehicle license plates; requiring annual renewal
- 5 and validation decal; increasing fees; specifying
- 6 applicability; and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 Section 1. W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xv)(A), 31-2-204(b),
- 11 31-2-213(b), 31-2-223(a), (b)(intro), by creating new
- 12 paragraphs (iv) and (v) and (c), 31-3-102(a)(xiii)(A), (B)
- 13 and by creating a new subparagraph (C) and
- 14 31-16-101(a)(xxi) are amended to read:

3	(a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this
4	act:

6	(xv) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle which
7	is self-propelled except vehicles moved solely by human
8	power, electric bicycles or motorized skateboards. The
9	term includes the following vehicles as hereafter defined:

L1	(A) "Antique" means any motor vehicle which
L2	is at least twenty five (25) fifty (50) years old and owned
L3	solely as a collectors item;

L8	(b) Except as otherwise provided, license plates
L9	shall be of metal not less than twelve (12) inches long in
20	the left-hand end of which shall be arabic numerals for the
21	county in which issued, followed by the bucking horse and
22	rider emblem and a distinctive number assigned to the

vehicle, set forth in numerals and letters as determined by

the department and above or underneath such numerals shall 1 2 be the word "Wyoming" and arabic numerals for the year of 3 issue or validation. License plates issued to dealers and 4 for state or federal official forestry vehicles, motorcycles, multipurpose vehicles trailers 5 and shall contain appropriate identification which may be in lieu of 6 the bucking horse and rider emblem. After the county number 7 8 on the left-hand end, the license plate may also contain a 9 distinctive symbol or letters, as determined by the 10 department, indicating vehicle type. License plates shall 11 be changed or validated annually. There shall be a marked 12 contrast between the color of the plate and that of the 13 numerals and letters and the background of all plates shall be fully reflectorized. Plates for light utility trailers 14 (1,000)15 thousand pounds, under one motorcycles and 16 multipurpose vehicles shall not be less than three (3) 17 inches wide and six (6) inches long. Antique license plates issued on or after July 1, 2021 shall bear no date the year 18 19 of issue or validation and shall bear the inscription 20 "Pioneer Wyo". Distinctive license farm stickers shall be 21 issued by the county treasurer upon request for trucks and used 22 trailers by any farmer or rancher for the 23 transportation of livestock, feed or unprocessed

- 1 agricultural products owned and produced by the farmer or
- 2 rancher from the place of production to market and of ranch
- 3 supplies intended solely for the use of the farmer or
- 4 rancher, and not for sale, on the return trip, and not for
- 5 the transportation of goods and persons for hire. Farm
- 6 stickers shall bear the inscription "Farm".

- 8 31-2-213. Department to supply registration
- 9 certificates, plates and stickers; removable windshield
- 10 placards.

- 12 (b) The department may issue license plates, except
- 13 dealer and antique motor vehicle license plates, which
- 14 shall be valid for not more than eight (8) years if annual
- 15 validation stickers are attached in the upper left corner
- 16 of the license plate with the month and year of expiration
- 17 clearly visible. An antique motor vehicle license plate
- 18 <u>issued on or after July 1, 2021 shall be valid for the</u>
- 19 <u>duration of the registered owner's ownership if annual</u>
- 20 <u>validation stickers are attached as required in this</u>
- 21 <u>subsection</u>. Department authorized license plates and annual
- 22 stickers shall be of colors that are readily
- 23 distinguishable from the previous year. Annual validation

2	(c) Upon receipt of an approved application and
3	payment of fees the vehicle shall be registered and license
4	plates issued therefor. The registration shall be renewed
5	annually and expires upon transfer of ownership of the
6	vehicle. Notwithstanding W.S. 31-2-205(a)(i)(A), a license
7	plate shall only be required to be displayed on the rear of
8	those antique motor vehicles that were originally
9	manufactured to have one (1) license plate.

3 (a) As used in this act:

4

5 (xxi) "Antique vehicle" means a motor vehicle
6 which is at least twenty-five (25) forty (40) years old;

7

8 Section 2. This act applies to all vehicles as of July 1, 2021. If as of July 1, 2021 a vehicle is at least 9 10 twenty-five (25) years old but not of a model year of 1979 11 or earlier and if as of July 1, 2021 the owner has already 12 registered the vehicle according to W.S. 31-2-223, obtained 13 license plates according to W.S. 31-2-204(b) and displayed them according to W.S. 31-2-205(a)(i)(A)(VII), then the 14 15 vehicle may continue to operate designated as an antique 16 vehicle. For a vehicle that is at least twenty-five (25) 17 years old but not of a model year of 1979 or earlier and 18 that previously had license plates designating it as an 19 antique, that registration expires upon transfer 20 ownership of the vehicle, consistent with the expiration in 21 W.S. 31-2-223(c), and this act applies thereafter.

1 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
