for

AN ACT relating to the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship program; modifying the transfer of funds from the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship expenditure account to the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship endowment fund; modifying the calculation of the average market value of the Wyoming's

7 transferring funds as specified; and providing for an

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

12 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1902(a) and (c) is amended to

5 (a) Except otherwise provided by as law, the scholarship expenditure account 6 Wyoming's tomorrow 7 created to consist of all earnings from the Wyoming's 8 tomorrow scholarship endowment fund created bу W.S. 9 9-4-204(u)(ix) and other funds appropriated by 10 legislature to the expenditure account. Funds within the 11 expenditure account may be invested as authorized by law. 12 Interest and other earnings from amounts within the expenditure account shall be credited to the expenditure 13 14 account. Monies within the expenditure account 15 continuously appropriated to the state treasurer for 16 distribution to eliqible institutions based on scholarships 17 awarded by the commission under this article, subject to limitations provided for under subsection (b) of this 18 19 section. As soon as possible after the end of each of the 20 fiscal years beginning on and after July 1, 2022, the state treasurer shall transfer monies from the expenditure 21 22 account to the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship endowment fund to the extent monies within the expenditure account 23

1	are in excess of an amount equal to nine percent (9%)
2	twenty-one percent (21%) of the previous five (5) year
3	average market value of the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship
4	endowment fund, calculated from the first day of the fiscal
5	year, except as provided for under subsection (c) of this
6	section. The state treasurer shall report not later than
7	November 1, of each year to the joint education interim
8	committee and the select committee on capital financing and
9	investments the amount of funds within the expenditure
10	account at the end of the previous fiscal year and as of
11	July 1, of the current fiscal year.

13	(c) The annual average market value of the Wyoming's
14	tomorrow scholarship endowment fund shall be calculated as
15	follows for the fiscal year (FY) specified:

17	(i) FY $\frac{2023}{2024}$ shall be equal to the market
18	value of the Wyoming's tomorrow scholarship endowment fund,
19	calculated from the first business day of the fiscal year;

- 3 (a) On July 1, 2023, the state auditor shall transfer
- 4 five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the legislative
- 5 stabilization reserve account to the Wyoming's tomorrow
- 6 scholarship expenditure account.

- 8 (b) On July 1, 2023, the state auditor shall transfer
- 9 sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000.00) from the legislative
- 10 stabilization reserve account to the Wyoming's tomorrow
- 11 scholarship endowment fund.

12

- 13 (c) On July 1, 2023, the state auditor shall transfer
- 14 ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund
- 15 to the Wyoming works program account created by W.S.
- 16 21-18-408(a).

17

- 18 (d) On July 1, 2023, the state auditor shall transfer
- 19 five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) from the general fund
- 20 to the Wyoming works student grant account created by W.S.
- $21 \quad 21-18-408(b)$.

Section 3. To the extent any provision of this act conflicts with any provision of 2023 House Bill 0109, as enacted into law, the provisions of this act shall control.

Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
