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14 (a) As used in this act:

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1	(x) "Health care facility" means any ambulatory
2	surgical center, assisted living facility, adult day care
3	facility, adult foster care home, alternative eldercare
4	home, birthing center, boarding home, convalescent care
5	<pre>center, freestanding diagnostic testing center, home health</pre>
6	agency, hospice, hospital, intermediate care facility for
7	people with intellectual disability, medical assistance
8	facility, nursing care facility, rehabilitation facility
9	and renal dialysis center;
10	
11	(xxvi) "Convalescent care center" means a
12	facility with the primary purpose of providing recovery
13	care services to a patient who is discharged within
14	seventy-two (72) hours after admittance and the facility is
15	not a section or ward of any hospital;
16	
17	(xxvii) "Recovery care services" means post-
18	surgical and post-diagnostic medical and general nursing
19	care provided to a patient where acute care hospitalization
20	is not required and an uncomplicated recovery is reasonably
21	expected. The term includes post-surgical rehabilitation
22	services, but does not include intensive care services,
23	coronary services or critical care services;
