AN ACT relating to professional licensing; granting the board of barber examiners authority to establish requirements as specified; providing a definition; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 33-7-101(a) by creating a new paragraph (vi) and by renumbering (vi) as (vii) and 33-7-209(a) (iii) are amended to read:

33-7-101. Definitions.

(a) As used in this act:

(vi) "Instructor" means a person licensed to teach barbering or any practices thereof in a school of barbering as defined by this act and rules of the board;

~~(vi)~~ (vii) "This act" means W.S. 33-7-101 through 33-7-211.

33-7-209. Qualifications for registration as barber; examination.

(a) A certificate of registration to practice barbering shall be issued upon passage of a board administered or board approved examination, and upon meeting all requirements set forth by board rule and regulation, to any person who files a completed application, accompanied by the required fees and documentation and who:

(iii) Is a cosmetologist or hair stylist licensed under W.S. 33-12-119 through 33-12-140, has completed ~~seven hundred fifty (750) hours of~~ training at an

approved barber school or college as set forth in board rules and regulations and passed an examination conducted by the board to determine his fitness for practice.

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
