Annual renewal; delivery of license plates 2 and stickers; staggered registration; permanent 3 registration of lightweight trailers. 4 5 Except otherwise provided vehicle (a) as registrations expire on the last day of the 6 registration month. Renewals are effective for one (1) year 7 8 beginning the first day of the month following the annual registration month. The initial registration for a vehicle 9 10 in this state expires on the last day of the annual registration month in the following year. Except 11 12 provided in subsection (h) and in subsections (n) through (q) of this section, nothing in this section prohibits an 13 owner from registering a vehicle for more than twelve (12) 14 15 but less than twenty-four (24) months. 16 17 (n) The owner of a trailer as defined in W.S. 31-1-101(a)(xxiii) may permanently register the trailer 18 19 upon payment of a fee in the amount of five hundred dollars 20 (\$500.00) at the time of initial registration or payment of

(a) Except as provided by subsections (b) through (d) 6 (e) of this section, upon transfer of ownership of a 7 8 vehicle the registration of the vehicle expires and the 9 original owner shall immediately remove the license plates from the vehicle. Within sixty (60) days after acquiring 10 11 another vehicle for which the license plates would be 12 proper, the original owner may file an application for the 13 transfer of the license registration number to a vehicle acquired by him accompanied by the fees based on the amount 14 15 which would be due on a new registration as of the date of 16 transfer less any credit for the unused portion of the 17 original registration fees for the original vehicle for the assignment of the plates to the recently acquired vehicle 18 19 subject to the following:

(e) Upon transfer of ownership of a trailer that had been permanently registered under W.S. 31-2-206(n) the permanent registration of that trailer expires and the

1	original owner shall immediately remove the license plate
2	from that trailer. If within sixty (60) days after the
3	transfer of ownership the original owner acquires another
4	trailer for which the permanent license plate would be
5	proper, the original owner may file an application for the
6	transfer of the license registration number to the newly
7	acquired trailer and the license plate may be transferred
8	by the original owner to the original owner's newly
9	acquired trailer. The original owner is not subject to
10	additional registration fees for the transfer of the
11	license registration number under this subsection.
