1 AN ACT relating to membership of the state board of

2 education; modifying the membership to include the

3 president of the University of Wyoming as a nonvoting

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-301(a) is amended to read:

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10 21-2-301. Appointment; qualifications, terms and

11 removal of members; meetings; chairman.

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13 (a) There is created a state board of education

14 composed of thirteen (13) fourteen (14) members, eleven

15 (11) of whom shall be appointed members with at least one

16 (1) member appointed from each appointment district

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W.S. 9-1-218. Appointments 1 pursuant to from each 2 appointment district shall be rotated among the several 3 counties comprising the district. The remaining voting 4 member of the board shall be the state superintendent of public instruction. The executive director of the Wyoming 5 community college commission and the president of the 6 University of Wyoming, or their designees, shall be an 7 8 ex-officio member members and shall not have the right to 9 vote. One (1) appointed member shall be appointed at large and shall be a certified classroom teacher at the time of 10 11 appointment. One (1) appointed member shall also 12 appointed at large and shall be a certified school administrator at the time of appointment. Two (2) appointed 13 14 shall be appointed at large and shall members 15 representative of private business or industry in Wyoming. 16 On and after March 1, 2013 and upon expiration of their 17 respective terms, the appointments of the two (2) members previously designated to be representative of business or 18 19 industry shall be at large, one (1) a representative of 20 Wyoming private business or industry and one (1) a member of a school district board of trustees at the time of 21 appointment. The first appointment to the term of such 22 23 member which expires on or after March 1, 2013, shall be a

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school district board member at the time of appointment. 1 2 The remaining seven (7) appointed members of the board 3 shall be appointed from among the lay citizens of the state 4 who are electors of the state, known for their public spirit, business or professional ability and interest in 5 education. Not more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the 6 appointed members of the board shall be from one 7 8 political party. Members shall be appointed for six (6) 9 year terms, except those who may be appointed to fill 10 unexpired terms. Members shall be appointed by the governor 11 with the approval of the senate. Vacancies shall be filled 12 by the governor without senate approval until the next 13 session of the legislature. No member is eligible to 14 reappointment, except any member appointed to fill unexpired term of less than six (6) years 15 16 reappointed for one (1) additional six (6) year term. Appointed members of the board may be removed by the 17
