Sales contracts entered into by the 17 commission shall be administered by the commission. To 18 optimize the amount of excess Stage II water available for 19 marketing without jeopardizing water supplies necessary to 20 meet the city of Cheyenne's municipal needs, the city shall 21 develop a Stage II management plan acceptable to the water development commission and the state engineer. The board 22 23 shall transfer thirty-seven and three-tenths percent
