Barber licensing amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to barber licensing; establishing an
2 official symbol for barbers; amending the grounds upon
3 which a license may be revoked, suspended or withheld;
4 amending licensing requirements; requiring rulemaking; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-7-113 is created to read:

10

11 **33-7-113. Barber poles; official symbol; display.**

12

13 A stationary or rotating pole with diagonal stripes of red
14 and white or red, white and blue shall be known as a barber
15 pole and shall be the symbol of the practice of barbering.

1 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-7-207(a)(vii) and by creating a
2 new paragraph (ix) and 33-7-209(a)(iii) are amended to
3 read:

4
5 **33-7-207. Refusal to issue or renew; revocation;**
6 **suspension; denial.**

7
8 (a) The board may revoke, suspend, deny, or refuse to
9 issue or renew any certificate of registration or
10 barbershop or barber school license, or may otherwise
11 censure the holder of a certificate of registration or
12 barbershop or barber school license for any of the
13 following causes:

14
15 (vii) Unprofessional conduct; ~~and~~

16
17 (ix) A judicial disposition of guilt or a plea
18 of nolo contendere relative to a criminal offense which
19 adversely relates to the practice or instruction of
20 barbering.

22 **33-7-209. Qualifications for registration as barber;**
23 **examination.**

1 (a) A certificate of registration to practice
2 barbering shall be issued upon passage of a board
3 administered or board approved examination, and upon
4 meeting all requirements set forth by board rule and
5 regulation, to any person who files a completed
6 application, accompanied by the required fees and
7 documentation and who:

8
9 (iii) Is a cosmetologist or hair stylist
10 licensed under W.S. 33-12-119 through 33-12-140, has
11 completed ~~seven hundred fifty (750) hours of~~ training at an
12 approved barber school or college as set forth in rules
13 promulgated by the board and passed an examination
14 conducted by the board to determine his fitness for
15 practice.

16

17 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
