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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-218(a)(intro) and by creating a new
- 9 paragraph (viii) is amended to read:

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- 11 9-4-218. Federal natural resource policy account
- 12 created; purposes.

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- 14 (a) There is created an account known as the "federal
- 15 natural resource policy account." Funds within the account

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1	may be expended by the governor on behalf of the state of
2	Wyoming and its local governments, to take any of the actions
3	specified in this subsection in response related to federal
4	land, water, air, mineral and other natural resource policies
5	which may affect the tax base of the state, wildlife
6	management, state species, recreation, private property
7	rights, water rights or leasehold rights. Funds also may be
8	expended for preparing and participating in environmental
9	impact statements and environmental assessments, including
10	analysis of economic or social and natural or physical
11	environmental effects on the human environment. Funds also
12	may be expended for coordinating and participating in
13	rangeland health assessments pursuant to W.S. 11-2-207. The
14	governor may expend funds from the federal natural resource
15	policy account for:
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17	(viii) Development and revision of comprehensive
18	natural resource management plans prepared by counties.
19	Plans funded pursuant to this paragraph shall:
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21	(A) Identify objectives and priorities for
22	the use, development and protection of natural resources and
23	land in Wyoming;

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2	(B) Be based on criteria established by the
3	governor's office in consultation with the counties and
4	consistently applied in each comprehensive natural resource
5	management plan;
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7	(C) Serve as a basis for communicating and
8	coordinating with the federal government and its agencies on
9	land and natural resource management issues;
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11	(D) Be developed or revised in public
12	meetings held in accordance with W.S. 16-4-401 through
13	16-4-408. The public meetings shall allow for participation
14	and contribution from the public.
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16	Section 2. There is appropriated a one-time amount of
17	one million one hundred fifty thousand dollars
18	(\$1,150,000.00) from the general fund to the federal natural
19	resource policy account created in W.S. 9-4-218(a). The
20	governor shall only expend this appropriation for development
21	and revision of comprehensive natural resource management
22	plans pursuant to W.S. 9-4-218(a)(viii) provided that for the
23	period beginning with the effective date of this act and

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1	ending June 30, 2020, not more than fifty thousand dollars
2	(\$50,000.00) shall be granted to or expended for any one (1)
3	county in Wyoming. On and after July 1, 2020, the governor
4	may grant or expend the unexpended, unobligated and
5	uncommitted funds remaining from this appropriation for
6	development and revision of comprehensive natural resource
7	management plans for any county or counties. Notwithstanding
8	W.S. 9-4-218(b) or any other provision of law, these funds
9	shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose
10	and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
11	appropriation shall revert to the general fund on June 30,
12	2022.

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14 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2019.
