(v) In lieu of receiving the allowance specified in paragraph (iv) of this subsection, a member of the legislature may receive reimbursement up to one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per calendar quarter for mileage and lodging incurred in providing service to and on behalf of the member's constituents. Mileage reimbursement under this paragraph shall be at the rate established pursuant to W.S. 28-5-101(d) and computed as provided in W.S. 28-5-102. Lodging reimbursement under this paragraph shall be based on actual expenses. The member claiming the reimbursement shall

submit a verified claim to the legislative service office at
