W.S. 16-6-203(a)(ii) and (b) is amended to 8 9 read: 10 16-6-203. Required resident labor on public works 11 projects; exception. 12 13 (a) Every person who is charged with the duty of 14 15 construction, reconstructing, improving, enlarging, altering or repairing any public works project or 16

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improvement for the state or any political subdivision, 1 2 municipal corporation, or other governmental unit, shall 3 employ only Wyoming laborers on the project or improvement. 4 Every contract let by any person shall contain a provision requiring that Wyoming labor be used except other laborers 5 may be used when Wyoming laborers are not available for the 6 employment from within the state or are not qualified to 7 perform the work involved. The contract shall contain a 8 9 provision requiring specific acknowledgement of the requirements of this section. A person required to employ 10 11 Wyoming laborers may employ other than Wyoming laborers if:

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(ii) The state workforce center certifies that 13 the person's need for laborers cannot be filled from those 14 15 Wyoming laborers listed with the Wyoming department of 16 workforce services or from applications, including walk-in 17 applications, received by the person. The state workforce 18 center shall also certify that the qualifications for the 19 work set by the person are not arbitrary or unreasonable. 20 The department shall respond to a person's request for 21 certification within ten (10) days of the date the information is filed. 22

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1	(b) Upon request by the workforce center, the general
2	contractor shall provide the most recent construction
3	schedule for the project and any other information
4	necessary to make a certification under subsection (a) of
5	this section. The workforce center may require the general
6	contractor to provide a sworn statement related to
7	information required under this subsection.
