8 (B) Sales made to religious or charitable organizations including nonprofit organizations providing 9 meals or services to senior citizens as certified to the 10 11 department of revenue by the department of health in or for 12 the conduct of the regular religious, charitable or senior citizen functions and activities and sales of meals made to 13 14 persons senior citizens, guests of seniors and meals 15 delivered to the homebound in regular conduct of senior 16 citizen centers functions and activities;
