Unlawful manufacture or delivery; counterfeit substance; unlawful possession. 11 12 (c) It is unlawful for any person knowingly or 13 intentionally to possess a controlled substance unless the 14 substance was obtained directly from, or pursuant to a 15 valid prescription or order of a practitioner while acting 16

1	in the course of his professional practice, or except as
2	otherwise authorized by this act. Prescriptions or doctors'
3	orders for marihuana, tetrahydrocannabinol, or synthetic
4	equivalents of marihuana or tetrahydrocannabinol are not
