A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; establishing the  
2 crime of interference with emergency services; providing  
3 penalties; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-5-214 is created to read:

8

9 **6-5-214. Interference with emergency services;**  
10 **penalties.**

12 (a) A person commits a misdemeanor punishable by  
13 imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, a fine of not  
14 more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or both, if he

1 knowingly obstructs, impedes or interferes with a person  
2 providing emergency services.

4 (b) A person who intentionally and knowingly causes  
5 bodily injury to a person providing emergency services is  
6 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not  
7 more than one (1) year, a fine of not more than two  
8 thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), or both.

10 (c) For purposes of this section:

11

12 (i) "Emergency medical service personnel" means  
13 any emergency medical technician at any level who is  
14 certified by the department of health. "Emergency medical  
15 service personnel" includes a first responder certified by  
16 the department of health;

17

18 (ii) "Firefighter" means as defined in W.S.  
19 15-5-201(a)(xi) or (xiv);

20

21 (iii) "Health care provider" means as defined in  
22 W.S. 35-2-605(a)(viii);

23

1           (iv) "Person providing emergency services" means  
2 a health care provider, firefighter or emergency medical  
3 service personnel providing care or assistance at the place  
4 of an emergency or accident in the state, regardless of  
5 whether they are paid or volunteer.

6

7           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
