(xviii) "Minor political party" means a political organization whose candidate for any one (1) of the offices of the United States house of representatives, governor or secretary of state, received not less than two percent (2%) nor more than ten percent (10%) of the total votes cast for that office in either of the ~~most recent two~~ (2) immediately succeeding general ~~election~~ elections after the election in which the party has attained ballot access;

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2014.
