## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to pari-mutuel wagering; providing for
- 2 distribution of fees to the general fund as specified; and
- 3 providing for an effective date.

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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-25-105(b)(ii), (iii), by creating
- 8 a new paragraph (iv) and (d) is amended to read:

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- 10 11-25-105. Pari-mutuel permits; fees and reports;
- 11 disposition of funds; enforcement of provisions.

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- 13 (b) Every Wednesday following any pari-mutuel event,
- 14 the permittee shall:

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1 (ii) Pay an amount equal to one-half percent 2  $\frac{(1/2\%)}{(0.5\%)}$  of the total amount wagered attributable to 3 historic pari-mutuel events and one and one-half percent +1 4  $\frac{1/2}{0}$  of the total amount wagered attributable to live pari-mutuel events, shown by the report to the 5 commission, to be credited by the state treasurer to a 6 separate account, in the manner indicated in subsection (d) 7 8 of this section; and 9 10 (iii) Pay an amount equal to one percent (1%) of 11 the total amount wagered attributable to historic 12 pari-mutuel events, shown by the report to the commission, 13 to be transferred by the commission to the county and the 14 city or town in which the permittee is located, in equal shares, or to the county alone if the permittee is not 15 16 located within the boundaries of a city or town; - and 17 18 (iv) Pay an amount equal to one-half percent 19 (0.5%) of the total amount wagered attributable to historic 20 pari-mutuel events, shown by the report to the commission, 21 to be credited by the state treasurer to the general fund. 22

(d) All sums paid to the commission under this act 1 2 except contributions from permittees to the breeder award 3 fund, amounts paid under paragraph (b)(iii) or (iv) of this 4 section, fines and penalties shall be credited to the pari-mutuel account which shall be used by the commission 5 for the payment of all expenses incurred in enforcing this 6 act. All fines and penalties collected under this act shall 7 8 be paid to the state treasurer and credited as provided in W.S. 8-1-109. The state treasurer shall pay out of the 9 10 account all warrants drawn by the state auditor, upon vouchers issued and signed by the president, vice-president 11 12 or executive secretary of the commission. The commission 13 shall keep an accurate and true account of all funds 14 received and all vouchers issued by the commission. All 15 funds received and all vouchers issued by the commission 16 shall be audited at least biennially by the director of the state department of audit or his designee and a copy of the 17 18 audit shall be delivered within thirty (30) days after 19 completion to the governor and the commission. The costs of 20 the audit shall be borne by the commission. The members of 21 the commission shall receive per diem and mileage as provided in W.S. 33-1-302(a)(vii), and compensation of 22 23 fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day during which they are

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1 actually engaged in the discharge of their duties. The

2 total expenses incurred by the commission shall not exceed

3 the total amount in the pari-mutuel account.
