11	(a) As used in this chapter:

13	(i) "Average daily membership" or "ADM" means
14	the aggregate number of pupils present plus the aggregate
15	number of pupils absent, divided by the actual number of

days the school is in session for the year. Pupils who 1 2 attend at least eighty percent (80%) seventy-five percent 3 (75%) of a full time equivalency basis shall be considered 4 full time. For pupils enrolled in school on less than eighty percent (80%) seventy-five percent (75%) of a full 5 time equivalency basis, the school district shall calculate 6 the pupil's contribution to the ADM on a prorated basis 7 8 with the hours or class periods of enrollment being the numerator and the hours or class periods of full time 9 10 equivalency being the denominator. Pupils who have withdrawn from school or who have been absent for more than 11 12 ten (10) consecutive calendar days shall not be counted as 13 members; 14 Section 2. This act shall apply beginning school year 15 16 2023-2024. 17 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2023. 18 19 20 (END)
