- 17 resulting from or arising out of an occurrence involving
- 18 the transportation or storage of a firearm in a motor
- 19 vehicle on property designated for motor vehicle parking.
- 20 This immunity shall not apply to acts or omissions
- 21 unrelated to compliance with this act, constituting gross

1 (d) Nothing in this act shall be construed to expand 2 any existing duty, or create any additional duty, on the 3 part of an employer or that employer's agent. 4 27-16-104. Exemptions. 5 6 7 (a) The provisions of this act allowing the 8 transportation or storage of firearms in motor vehicles shall not apply to: 9 10 11 (i) The University of Wyoming, community 12 colleges and schools, including any school building or school grounds in Wyoming and other properties owned or 13 14 leased by a school; 15 (ii) Government entities, including the federal 16 17 government and its agencies, state agencies, cities, towns, counties and political subdivisions of the state; 18 19 20 (iii) Religious organizations, including 21 religious organizations acting as an employer.
