2	purport to relieve the indemnitee from loss or liability
3	arising from negligent acts are against public policy and
4	are void and unenforceable:

6	(iv) All agreements, covenants or promises
7	contained in, collateral to or affecting any agreement
8	pertaining to any well for operation related to oil, gas,
9	other minerals, or water, or mine for any mineral, which
10	purport to indemnify the indemnitee against <pre>damages,</pre> loss
11	or liability: for damages for:

13	(A) Caused by the sole or concurrent
14	negligence of the indemnitee, the agents or employees of
15	the indemnitee or any independent contractor who is
16	directly responsible to the indemnitee; or
