Suspension ordismissal of teachers; 5 notice; hearing; independent hearing officer; board review 6 and decision; appeal. 7 The board may suspend or dismiss any teacher or 8 9 terminate any continuing contract teacher for incompetency, 10 neglect duty, immorality, insubordination, of unsatisfactory performance or any other good or just cause. 11 If the board determines to suspend a teacher pursuant to 12 13 this subsection, the suspension shall be with pay pending 14 the outcome of an investigation by the superintendent or his designee into the alleged misconduct of the teacher. 15 Following the investigation, the superintendent shall 16 17 recommend reinstatement or initiate suspension proceedings under subsection (b) of this section. pursuant to a majority vote of the board delivering to the 1 2 teacher a written notice of suspension or dismissal, together with written reasons. Following an investigation 3 4 under subsection (a) of this section, the superintendent 5 may initiate suspension proceedings by delivering to the teacher a written notice of suspension together with 6 7 written reasons including the outcome of the investigation conducted by the superintendent or his designee. 8 9 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2011. 10
