- 12 **16-6-102.** Resident contractors; preference limitation
- 13 with reference to lowest bid or qualified response;
- 14 decertification; denial of application for residency.

1 (a) If a contract is let by the state, any department 2 thereof, or any county, city, town, school district, 3 community college district or other public corporation of 4 the state for the erection, construction, alteration or 5 repair of any public building, or other public structure, or for making any addition thereto, or for any public work 6 improvements, the contract shall be 7 let, if advertisement for bids or request for proposal is not 8 9 required, to a resident of the state. Unless an alternate 10 design and construction delivery method is used, if 11 advertisement for bids or request for proposal is required, 12 the contract shall be let to the responsible certified 13 resident making the lowest bid if the certified resident's 14 bid is not more than five percent (5%) higher than that of 15 the lowest responsible nonresident bidder.

Responsibilities under alternative delivery 9 contracts. 10 11 (a) Any construction manager agent, construction 12 manager at risk or design-builder contract awarded shall 13 comply with any reporting and administrative requirements as required by the public entity of the recipient of a 14 design, bid and build contract, including retainage, 15 payment and performance bonding and default of contract. 16 17 (b) All contracts let under this section including 18 19 subcontractor bids, shall be opened in public following 20 reasonable public notice. 21 22 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
