1 (xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" 2 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county 3 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized 4 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the 5 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), investigator employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 6 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 7 8 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, probation and parole agent employed by the Wyoming department of 9 10 corrections, Wyoming law enforcement academy instructor, 11 University of Wyoming campus police officer, community 12 college police officer, detention officer or dispatcher for 13 law enforcement agencies; 14 Section 2. Coverage of a community college police 15 16 officer as a law enforcement member under W.S. 9-3-432, as 17 required by section 1 of this act, shall commence on July 1, 2019, unless a community college police officer elects to 18 19 continue participation in the Wyoming Retirement Act as a 20 general member. An election shall be made by providing notice 21 to the Wyoming retirement board not later than April 30, 2019. Once an election is made it shall not be rescinded. Service 22
