(a) A person who knowingly reports falsely to a 911 1 2 emergency reporting system, law enforcement agency or a 3 fire department that: 4 5 6-5-212. Interference with emergency calls; interference with emergency reporting system. 6 7 (b) A person commits a misdemeanor if he knowingly 8 9 calls a 911 emergency reporting system for a purpose other 10 than to report a situation that he reasonably believes 11 requires prompt service in order to preserve or protect human life or health or property. 12 13 14 (b)(c) For purposes of this section article "911 emergency reporting system" means as defined by W.S. 15 16-9-102(a)(iv). 16 17 18 Section 2.
