1 (c) No person or organization holding the special 2 malt beverage and wine permit shall sell any alcoholic 3 liquor other than malt beverages and manufactured wines on 4 the premises described on the permit, nor shall any malt 5 beverage or manufactured wine be sold for consumption off 6 the premises authorized by the permit. It shall be the duty and obligation of the issuing body and the holder of the 7 8 permit to see that no sales are made to any person under 9 the age of twenty-one (21) years.
