A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the legislature; increasing the
2 legislative per diem rate as specified; providing
3 appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-5-101(b) is amended to read:

8

9 **28-5-101. Schedule of compensation, per diem and**
10 **travel expenses.**

11

12 (b) The amount to be received by each member of the
13 legislature for expenses shall be ~~one hundred nine dollars~~
14 ~~(\$109.00)~~ one hundred twenty-nine dollars (\$129.00) per
15 day.

2 **Section 2.**

4 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to
5 the legislative service office one hundred thousand dollars
6 (\$100,000.00) to supplement legislative per diem for the
7 period beginning July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

8

9 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this
10 section, there is appropriated from the general fund to the
11 state auditor ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for the
12 period beginning July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016, to be
13 distributed as necessary to supplement per diem for any
14 state board, commission, council, authority or other state
15 entity whose per diem rate is based upon the amount of per
16 diem paid to state legislators.

18 (c) For employees of any state board, commission,
19 council, authority or other state entity whose per diem
20 rate is based upon the amount of per diem paid to state
21 legislators, but whose per diem is paid from nongeneral
22 fund sources, there is appropriated from those accounts and
23 funds the amounts necessary to provide payment of the

1 increases in per diem authorized under this act for the
2 period beginning July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
