1 AN ACT relating to states rights; limiting the commerce
2 clause from controlling articles within the borders of
3 Wyoming; and providing for an effective date.

12 **16-12-101. Interstate commerce.**

13

14 Federal authority under the interstate commerce clause
15 shall not be construed to include any further control over
16 articles in interstate commerce other than to mandate
17 unhampered and unobligated passage from one (1) state to

1 another state over articles in interstate commerce. The
2 interstate commerce clause shall not have any permanent
3 lawful authority over any article tangible or intangible,
4 living or inert. The control of all articles under
5 interstate commerce control, upon reaching their
6 destination within the borders of Wyoming, shall be
7 relinquished. The interstate commerce commission shall
8 relinquish all authority and control over such items which
9 shall include all articles and items under the bureau of
10 alcohol, tobacco, firearms and explosives that have reached
11 their destination within the borders of Wyoming.

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
