A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to fuel taxes; restricting the expenditure  
2 of a specified portion of fuel taxes; requiring a report;  
3 and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-17-111(d) (iv) and  
8 39-17-211(d) (ii) (C) are amended to read:

10 **39-17-111. Distribution.**

12 (d) After certifying the amounts provided by  
13 subsection (c) of this section, the department shall  
14 certify the balance of taxes collected under this article  
15 to the state treasurer who shall distribute the remainder

1 into the accounts within the state highway fund created  
2 under this subsection as follows:

4 (iv) Fifty-seven and one-half percent (57.5%) to  
5 the state highway account. Any funds deposited to the  
6 highway fund under this paragraph which are attributable to  
7 the increase in fuel taxes authorized by 2013 Wyoming  
8 Session Laws, Chapter 49, Section 1 and effective July 1,  
9 2013 shall be separately accounted for by the department of  
10 transportation and shall only be expended to maintain the  
11 state highway system and to prepare the report required by  
12 this paragraph. The department shall provide a  
13 comprehensive report to the joint appropriations interim  
14 committee and the joint transportation, highways and  
15 military affairs interim committee on or before November 15  
16 of each year.

20 (d) The state treasurer shall:

(C) The remaining revenues shall be credited to the state highway fund for the maintenance, construction and reconstruction of state highways. Any funds deposited to the highway fund under this subparagraph which are attributable to the increase in fuel taxes authorized by 2013 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 49, Section 1 and effective July 1, 2013 shall be separately accounted for by the department of transportation and shall only be expended to maintain the state highway system and to prepare the report required by this subparagraph. The department shall provide a comprehensive report to the joint appropriations interim committee and the joint transportation, highways and military affairs interim committee on or before November 15 of each year.

**Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
