A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to fire protection and electrical safety; amending fees collected by the department of 2 fire prevention and electrical safety; codifying a limit for 3 plan review and inspection fees; increasing fee limits for 4 specified fees; amending the distribution and permissible 5 of fee revenue; making technical corrections; 6 uses 7 conforming and updating terms; requiring rulemaking; and providing for effective dates. 8

10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 11

Section 1. W.S. 35-9-108(d), (e), (h), (q)(i) through (iii) and (r), 35-9-120(c)(i)(A) through (F), (ii) and (f), 35-9-121(b)(intro) and 35-9-129(a)(i) through (viii), (x) and (b) are amended to read:

For the purpose of this section, school buildings 6 used as educational occupancies shall be construed to be state 7 8 buildings. If local code provisions are more stringent 9 than adopted state codes, the local code prevails. The 10 authority granted to local governmental entities under this subsection is subject to certification of local inspectors 11 12 as follows: 13 14 35-9-129.
